Comments: An application for change was sent to the Quality Assurance Monitor in December to add an additional space to the current location and to increase the licensed numbers by 15. This change is still awaiting approval from all three departments. During the inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor was informed by an educator and by the administrator that children are using the new space daily. Although the increase in numbers is not yet in effect, children already under the licence are using the new space and should not be doing so without approval of the Minister. The Quality Assurance Monitor informed the administrator that, as of now, the space can no longer be used until approval from Early Learning and Child Care Licensing staff, as well as statements of compliance from the fire inspector and the Public Health Inspector, have been received. Only approved indoor spaces may be used for regular activities.			

General Comments
The Quality Assurance Monitor (QAM) conducted an on-site monitoring inspection during the morning. At the time of the visit, the children were not present, as they were at the park for their scheduled outdoor time. During the inspection, the QAM reviewed and verified the following: - Daily programming with the two educators present at the time of the visit - new staff member's file - Indoor play area - Indoor play materials and equipment - Washroom facilities - Storage spaces - Storage areas for personal belongings
