| Comments: Each room must have supplies for children to have access to art supplies at all times. In one room there were no crayons, markers, pencil crayons ,paints or pencils. The staff stated they had given them to the other class. These items should be available in each room at all times. | | | |

| Comments: One staff member has an expired criminal record and vulnerable sector check. They must have an updated check completed. | | | |

| Comments: Childrens absences must be recorded to indicate illnesses. Many absences were not marked with the appropriate number indicating the reason for absence for the week of March 4th 2024. | | | |

| Comments: The current Quality Assurance Monitor and Inspector's names must replace the former in the visible postings. | | | |

| Comments: Quality Assurance Monitor noted two Emergency Allergy Management plans tacked to the visible postings board. One child is allergic to nuts, but the allergy is not indicated on the plan. There must be visible postings for severe allergies that are obvious to anyone entering the facility. These should be posted at each door to the facility to ensure the safety of children. | | | |

| Comments: In the washroom, the Quality Assurance Monitor noted that one stall has a toilet paper holder that has been pulled off the wall. It is a long wooden board with several screws exposed. The drywall has also been pulled off the wall, with a portion of the interior chiprock exposed. This is not able to be cleaned properly, and must be repaired in order to ensure the ability to properly clean the washroom. | | | |
