There must be visible postings for severe allergies that are obvious to anyone entering the facility. These should be posted at each door to the facility to ensure the safety of children.

Comments:	In the washroom, the Quality Assurance Monitor noted that one stall has a toilet paper holder that has been pulled off the wall. It is a long wooden board with several screws exposed. The drywall has also been pulled off the wall, with a portion of the interior chiprock exposed. This is not able to be cleaned properly, and must be repaired in order to ensure the ability to properly clean the washroom.						

General Comments

Quality Assurance Monitor inspected the following items during the monitoring inspection:

Quality Assurance Monitor observed children engaged in freeplay, eating lunch, cleaning up after lunch, and beginning a planned lego competition.

Quality Assurance Monitor spoke with Administrator regarding the visible postings board and ensuring out of date information is removed.

One toilet stall was marked Out of Service, but Administrator confirmed it worked and removed the sign. Quality Assurance Monitor discussed how to label each room on this license in order to ensure that they are easily identifiable.
