The administrator stated that they consistently do verifications to dispose of broken objects and that a verification was completed recently. The administrator confirmed that another check would be conducted. A confirmation that the objects have been removed can be sent to the Quality Assurance Monitor as proof of compliance.

Comments: During the inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed that the large school age area did not contain an area providing shade as per Regulation. The administrator shares that when they had opened, they had planned for the wooded area to serve this purpose however the children are not in that area on a day-to-day basis which means that this does not meet the intended Regulation. The operator must add a shaded area in the school age outdoor area. Photos of the shaded areas can be sent to the Quality Assurance Monitor as proof of compliance.
