The inspector observed that the infants are showing signs of being tired: rubbing eyes, crying but are being made to wait to go to bed because it was not 12 o'clock yet. Children had to stay in their highchair even if they had finished their lunch until it was time to go to bed. When asked by the inspector about the nap time routine, the educators questioned in both infants' rooms stated it was not nap time yet and they have been told by the administrator that they can't put the children down for naps before 12 o'clock. The daily routine of a licensed facility shall include a period of rest for a length of time that meets the needs of each infant and preschool child.

The inspector observed that when children are waking up, they are not allowed to get up and they have to stay on their nap mats or playpens until 2 pm. Children who do not rest the entire time are allowed to get up and play quietly or join other children who are not resting. A separate space is provided for children who do not nap, so they do not disturb resting children. Children who do not nap are not required to rest, but they may play quietly. The daily routine must be adjusted to ensure that the rest time meets the needs of each infant and preschool child.
