All educators must hold a valid first aid certificate and a valid cardiopulmonary resuscitation certificate. The two educators cannot be left alone with children until they have a valid first aid certificate and a valid cardiopulmonary resuscitation certificate.			
12(2) An operator of a licensed facility shall ensure that a criminal record check or a vulnerable sector check, as the case may be, and a check with the Department of Social Development is conducted on each individual before he or she becomes a staff member.	12(2)	Nov 21, 2022	Jan 11, 2023
Comments: While conducting the follow-up inspection, the inspector verified the staff files, and the vulnerable sector check was added to the file. Deficiency is now compliant.			
22 The daily routine of a licensed facility shall include (b) a period of rest for a length of time that meets the needs of each infant and preschool child receiving services at the licensed facility but that does not exceed two consecutive hours unless there is a written request from a child's parent or guardian to extend the length of time.	22(b)	Nov 21, 2022	Jan 11, 2023
Comments: While conducting the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that the daily routine has been adjusted to ensure that the rest time meets the needs of each infant and preschool child. Deficiency is now compliant.			
24(1) For the purposes of subsection 20(1) of the Act, the following records and documents shall be maintained on the premises of a licensed facility: (b) child records that include: (v) the child's health history and a copy of the record of immunizations or a copy of an exemption.	24(1)(b)(v)	Nov 25, 2022	Jan 11, 2023
Comments: The inspector verified 10 child files and all child files are meeting requirements. Deficiency is now compliant.

The two educators cannot be left alone with children until they have a valid first aid certificate and a valid cardiopulmonary resuscitation certificate.

Comments: While conducting the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that the daily attendance records are not completed. The daily attendance records must be accurate and reflect all children present at any given time and showing all absences with the detailing the reason with the codes.			
31(4) An operator shall ensure that the outdoor play area of a licensed facility (b) consists of more than one surface to permit different types of play.	31(4)(b)	Nov 25, 2022	
Comments: While conducting the follow-up inspection, the inspector was not able to verify if the outdoor playground consists of more than one surface because of the snow. It will be verified in a monitoring inspection in the spring.			
33(2) Stationary equipment in the outdoor play area shall be surrounded by a protective surfacing and installed according to the manufacturer's instructions.	33(2)	Dec 02, 2022	
Comments: While conducting the follow-up inspection, the inspector was not able to verify if the stationary equipment in the outdoor play area is surrounded by a protective surfacing because of the snow. It will be verified in a monitoring inspection in the spring.			
41(1) A licensed facility at which services are provided to children who wear diapers shall have a sturdy surface that is (c) located separate from the food preparation area and not used for serving food.	41(1)(c)	Nov 21, 2022	Jan 11, 2023
Comments: While conducting the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that there is no food stored in the bathroom. Deficiency is now compliant.			
47(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall refuse admission to a child if satisfactory proof of the immunizations required by the Public Health Act or the regulations under that Act is not provided.	47(1)	Nov 25, 2022	Jan 11, 2023
Comments: The inspector verified 10 child files and all child files are meeting requirements. Deficiency is now compliant.			
9(1) The child-to-staff ratio is one educator for each of the following groups of children of the same age receiving services at a full-time or part-time early learning and childcare centre: (a) three infants or fewer; (b) five children or fewer who are two years of age; (c) eight children or fewer who are three years of age; (d) ten children or fewer who are four years of age or older, but who are not yet attending school; and (e) 15 school-age children or fewer.	9(1)	Jan 11, 2023	
Comments: While conducting the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that a volunteer was alone with a group of children. A volunteer must never be left alone with children. The inspector had a conversation with the administrator on site and the volunteer will not be left alone with the children. The inspector also had a conversation with the administrator on site in regards of children going at the bathroom by themselves. Children must be supervised at all time even at the bathroom.
