Comments: The daily routine of a licensed facility shall include a period of rest for a length of time that meets the needs of each preschool child. The inspector observed that when children are waking up, they are not allowed to get up and they have to stay on their nap mats. Children who do not rest the entire time are allowed to get up and play quietly or join other children who are not resting. A separate space is provided for children who do not nap, so they do not disturb resting children. Children who do not nap are not required to rest, but they may play quietly. The daily routine must be adjusted to ensure that the rest time meets the needs of each child. The inspector had a conversation with the educators and they change the rest schedule. The children that was not sleeping was able to have some quiet play time. Deficiency is now compliant
