General Comments

Quality Assurance monitor arrived as children were coming inside from outdoor play, and other children were waking from naps. QAM observed children engaged in a variety of organized and freeplay activities, including magnetiles, a body craft, St.Patricks day coin choice and alphabet match, and painting. QAM watched children wash hands, prepare for snack, eat snack, and prepare to go outside. QAM overheard Educator heard asking what children would like to do voting with their hands; allowing children free choice.

Quality Assurance Monitor spoke with Educators regarding planning and documentation; and ensuring freedom of choice during both planned and freeplay activities.

Quality Assurance Monitor discussed sending an application for change when a new administrator begins.
