<p>General Comments</p> <p>During my unplanned visit in the morning, I observed compliance with the ratio. The following elements are observed during my visit:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Verification of 2 new files for staff members. - Medications are stored in a locked cabinet and kept out of children's reach. The administrative forms are duly completed and signed by the parents. - Personal belongings are separated and clearly labelled with each child's name. - The indoor play area is clean, safe, and has exposure to natural light. - The indoor play materials are varied, available in sufficient quantity for the number of children present, and stored on low, open shelves that are easily accessible. - Minor incidents are documented and signed by the parents. No major incidents were reported. - The forms related to the exclusion of children are duly completed and signed by the parents. - Administrative records maintained on-site. <p>Observation made during the visit, a snack consisting of bagels and fruit was provided by the daycare, two young children were put down for a nap, and the other children went outside during my visit.</p> <p>In conclusion, new posters on communicable diseases were distributed during my monitoring inspection. A total of three packets, each containing three posters, was provided.</p> <p>The posters covered the following topics:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Rashes, skin lesions, and itching in children - Diarrhea in children - Respiratory symptoms in children
