Comments: Two life-threatening allergies are present in the preschool class, these are not currently displayed in a visible and prominent location. All life-threatening allergies need to be posted in a visible and prominent location.

Comments: During the inspection, a cabinet with toxic products is unlocked. Inspector advised the educator, and the cabinet was locked immediately. Deficiency is now compliant.

Comments: 2 life threatening allergies in the preschool class that require EpiPens are not located on site. EpiPens must be on site, stored safely and easily accessible at all times.			

General Comments
During the renewal inspection, inspector observed the preschool class playing at the splash pad, playing freely indoors and snack time.
Inspector also observed the after-school class eating their snacks, educators explaining a Halloween activity. Positive interactions are also observed between educators and children.
