Comments: During the inspection, the QA Monitor observed a mini trampoline set up in a preschool room. A child was using the mini trampoline while the staff member was attending to the other children. Mini exercise trampolines may only be used for therapeutic purposes for children when used under the direction of physical or occupational therapist and with proper supervision. Operator, educators and parents/guardians must develop an Essential Routine Services and Emergency Plan (see Appendix 5 of the Operator Manual) if the trampoline is to be used for therapeutic purposes and ensure that the trampoline is only used with proper supervision.
