| <ul> <li>Visit done in the afternoon for a monitoring inspection.</li> <li>Ratio was respected during the visit.</li> <li>During the visit the facility used positive child guidance.</li> <li>The parent has access to the facility at any given time when their child is present.</li> <li>Individual space is provided for diapers, creams and wipes for each child who is not toilet trained. Changing area is located one metre or less from a sink. Diaper changing procedures are posted in a visible place in the diaper changing area. Children are always supervised during diaper changing.</li> <li>Facility has a separate locked storage space for medication.</li> <li>Administration of medication records are evident. Records are kept for each child when medication is administered.</li> <li>Toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies are locked and inaccessible to children.</li> <li>Observations:</li> <li>2-3-year-olds room: naptime, diaper changing, handwashing. The children that were not napping were looking at books.</li> <li>3-year-old room: Naptime. The two children who were not napping were playing with sensory bins. The children worked on an educational project. They made a bean bag toss game using cardboard.</li> <li>2-4-year-old room: Naptime and parent arrival.</li> <li>4-year-old room: Naptime. The children that were not napping were looking at books. The children were working on a group project. They are creating a tunnel for their cars using cardboard.</li> <li>Learning stories, children's pictures and children's art is seen throughout the centre at the child's level.</li> <li>Discussion with the director on medication and diaper changing procedures.</li> </ul> |                |                           |                      |                 |  |
