## **General Comments**

- Visit completed at the facility in the morning for a monitoring inspection.

- During the visit ratio was respected.

- Positive child guidance was witnessed.

- The parent board at the entrance of the facility has all required documents posted.

- Administrative records are maintained on-site. Monthly emergency evacuation and fire drills are completed.

- Daily activities are purposely planned and documented. The programming gives the children, time and space for a free choice of play experiences. Indoor and outdoor opportunities for physical activity either individually or in a group. Children have opportunities to explore various forms of literacy and to express creativity and interests. Learning stories and children's art is seen throughout the facility.

- Indoor play area materials and equipment are varied and in sufficient quantity for all children present. The materials are easily accessible and maintained clean and in good repair.

- Each child has an easily accessible space to store their personal belongings, which is labelled with their name and used only for the intended child.

- The quality improvement plan has been updated in the last year. Educators are on the right track to complete their 10 hours of professional learning development for the year.

- In the outdoor play area, there is no stationary equipment.

- Observations:

2-year-old room: The children created art, ate their lunch, washed their hands and diaper changing was witnessed.

3-year-old room: The educator read a story to the children. The children participated in a song box activity. The children picked an item out of the box. Each item was associated with a song. After the activity, the children washed their hands and had lunch.

3-4-year-old room: The children were playing outside. The children came inside washed their hands and had lunch.

4-year-old room: The children created art, then went outside to play. The children came in from outside, washed their hands and ate their lunch.

- Discussion with the educators concerning their documentation and planification. The educators shared their documentation. Each child has a portfolio. Discussion with the director the 4 new hires that do not have their first aid training cannot be alone with a group of children, may not open or close the facility.
