General Comments

Upon arriving at the facility, the children were getting ready to go play in the outdoor play area. The educators were observed helping the children zip up their jackets and put their hats and mittens on. A headcount was done before going outside and the educators were observed bringing their first aid bags and water bottles outside.

Once outside, the children engaged in various free play activities such as playing in the sand box and making "mud cakes and pizza". Other children were observed playing a tag game on the play structure. An educator was observed offering chalk to a group of children and kneeled down to draw with the children. Various and sufficient play materials were available to the children. Later, the educators put on music for the children to sign and dance. A group of educators were observed dancing and signing with the children. The educators were in touch with the children's needs by offering to wipe their noses and offering frequent water and washroom breaks. The educators encouraged the children to share resources and helped them resolve conflicts. When it was time to transition, the educators gave a verbal prompt to the children. Once it was time to go outside, the educators asked the children to line up and completed a headcount.

Once inside, the educators prompted the children to take their outdoor clothing off and properly store them in their labelled cubbies. The children agreed and then washed their hands for lunch time. An educator was observed helping the children open their lunch containers and encouraged them to eat their healthy foods before eating their "treats". The children were supervised at all times while eating their lunch. After eating lunch, the educators encouraged the children to clean up and put away their lunch boxes before returning to free play. The children agreed and engaged in free play in the dramatic play kitchen and in the cozy corner before "quiet time". An educator was observed preparing the sleeping cots for the children that would take a nap.

The indoor environment was clean and well organized. The parent information board was verified and found to be complete. The children's personal belongings were properly stored and labelled. Pictures of the children and learning stories were on display. Recent Halloween arts and crafts were present in the classroom. The educators were heard praising the children throughout the inspection. The staff files were verified and found to be complete.
