General Comments

Upon arriving at the facility, the children had not yet arrived. At 3pm, the children arrived at the facility with the educators. The educators encouraged the children to wash their hands and gather their lunch boxes to have a snack outside. During snack time the educators engaged in conversations with the children.

After eating the children engaged in free play activities outside such as playing soccer, football, playing in the mud kitchen and four squares. The educators were observed engaging in the children's activities while supervising. An educator was heard consoling a child that was crying. The educator kneeled to speak to the children and asked them if they were ok. Another educator was observed asking two children to share sport balls. Another group was observed playing on the monkey bars and on the play structure. The educators were playing with the children while supervising. The educators noticed a wasp's nest and asked the children to not play in that area. No safety hazards were found on the playground.

The indoor environment was clean and bright. Licensing staff observed age-appropriate books, variety in seating areas, loose parts, dramatic play kitchen and two large art and craft shelves. A bulletin board titled "Artist Showcase" contained various types of art near the back of the classroom. Another board featured pictures of the children engaging in various activities such as puppet shows, playing on the playground and building towers out of blocks.

The parent information board was verified and contained all necessary information. Monthly fire drills and playground safety checks were completed. Child profiles were also verified and found to be complete. Daily attendance was taken. The washrooms were clean, and the children's personal belongings were properly stored in their labelled cubbies.
