**General Comments**

Licensing staff arrived at the preschool program just as the children were finishing snack. They were located in the basement level, Unit B, which reflects a change in service done in October 2025. The preschool was divided into two groups with the smaller group and 1 educator at the front where everyone enters, and the larger group was toward the back section with 2 educators, both groups had inclusion support workers who worked closely with their charges in a peaceful and pleasant way.

After snack the larger group engaged in an Easter egg colouring and gluing craft and then read stories in the reading section. The educators read *Chipmunk Gets in Big Trouble*, *When Sophie Gets Really Really Angry* and *It's Good to Be Clean*. The children were very engaged in the story time and there were interesting discussions and exchanges between the children and their educators. Each child has their own learning story book and there were multiple examples of interesting activities that they had engaged in. This week there was a Scholastic Book Fair, taking place at the East Coast Learning Academy, and all the children were taking a field trip there to buy books for themselves.

The children prepared for outdoor play, the transition was smooth and everyone was eager to go outside. The outdoor play area is surrounded by old pine trees and is beside the St. John River. The outdoor play structure was very popular and there was a storage trunk with balls and containers for pouring as well as a small picnic table in their play area. They mentioned that they had new supplies to go outside but they are waiting for the mud to dry up a bit before bringing them outside. The children were very engaged in their own imaginative play and kicking balls. I noticed that some of the toys have gone over the fence and they mentioned that staff would be collecting it all up again soon.

The room was organized, clean and bright with lots of materials. The educators were kind, gentle, and patient with the children. The room was calm and positive and the educators were engaged and interested in the children's ideas and conversations. The child and staff profiles, fire drills, maintenance checks, and first aid kits were reviewed and found to be complete.
