Comments: Deficiency is now compliant During the monitoring inspection a child was observed napping on a cot in the napping area unattended while educators performed nap checks. Children napping on cots require supervision at all times. This was corrected and the child was observed being picked up for the afternoon and no other children were napping on cots for the remainder of the inspection.			

General Comments
<p>The infant room which has recently been added to the license was observed to be well organized and clean. The materials were developmentally appropriate for the age of the children present and promoted grasping, standing, sensory play and independence.</p> <p>Television/screen use was observed in three of the classrooms during the monitoring inspection on this date. Television viewing is to be limited and not used daily. Television viewing is not to occur in the infant room. This was discussed with the operator and the educators in the infant room. The educators in the infant room agreed that music could be used to replace the television within the room.</p> <p>Operator is to submit a change in service application for the outdoor play space alterations for the infant's space.</p> <p>Positive behaviour guidance was observed at all times.</p>
