General Comments
<p>Some children were outside playing when licensing staff arrived. The educators are enjoying the larger play area. The sand box has a variety of sand play materials and children are encouraged to take the materials to other areas to play. The children were being pushed in groups or pairs by the educators on the round swing with some children feeling relaxed and almost going to sleep. There were some broken boards on the box with rocks and need repair to ensure safety. There is a round swing in the outdoor area that will be removed as it will require protective surfacing. The operator mentioned it had been inside without any protection under but on a specific hanger that may add to its safety. There was no evidence of writing materials or books in the outdoor environment, so a recommendation is to ensure writing materials are available to children in and outside to build literate identities.</p> <p>The children in the two-year-old room sat at their tables waiting for lunch while the educator sang with the children and read. The educator was expressive in their reading aloud inviting children to ask and respond to questions about the book. Children's photos and names were posted in each room and crafts posted on the wall. Laminated sheets are posted in each room with colors, shapes, letters, numbers, and animals. Books were located in each room, but one educator noted that they needed some care and organization.</p> <p>The children in the infant room had a variety of nap schedules with some children sleeping in the morning and afternoon while had a nap after lunch. For children not napping, they were provided a quiet time for play and snuggles, if needed. The educators in the infant room were responsive to the children's needs and aware of behaviors around new people.</p> <p>Paint may need to be touched up on shelves and walls as some areas show excessive wear. New staff files were reviewed and there was some uncertainty about a vulnerable sector check, so the educator is asked to complete a new check. Staff signed statements and first aid certificates are included in each staff file. There are</p>

currently four educators and the administrator that have their early childhood education certificate and/or diploma. There is a television in the infant room that they don't use so a recommendation was made to remove it to have the space for materials.
