Comments: The inspector reviewed 13 children files and observed one file is missing the child's Medicare number. All children's files must have the child's name, address, birth date and Medicare number.			

General Comments
The inspector is on site to conduct the renewal inspection. During the inspection, the inspector observed the morning snack, indoor free play, outdoor play, and children participating in various activities, including crafts, painting with cars and board games such as Chess and Guess Who. The inspector also observed children engaged in outdoor activity including throwing a dart with paint on it against the wall. The inspector also observed the lunch period and noted positive child guidance practices, including staff speaking softly and respectfully to the children. The inspector discussed the outdoor play area with the administrator. The administrator informed the inspector that additional shade had been added; however, the tarp had broken. She showed the inspector photos of the damaged tarp, as well as the replacement tarp that had been ordered and is expected to arrive next week. The inspector requested that the administrator send a photo once the new tarp has been received and installed. In the meantime, there is shaded space available in the outdoor play area for the children. The inspector also discussed with the administrator the requirement to ensure that all children's personal belongings, including lunch boxes and water bottles, are clearly labelled with the child's name. A further discussion is held regarding an EpiPen that had expired. The administrator advised the inspector that the parent had already been notified and asked to provide a replacement EpiPen as soon as possible.
