General Comments

Licensing Staff arrived at the Facility to introduce themself and perform a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival the 2-year-old class was getting ready to go outside. A headcount was observed before the children left the classroom.

In the 3/4 class the children were enjoying an airplane craft, puzzles and making necklaces. The Educators were engaged in the activities, cheering and celebrating as the children worked together to finish their puzzle. The classroom is clean and organized. A new cozy corner has been added recently. There are 2 small couches, soft pillows and a bookshelf with age-appropriate books. The Educator mentioned the children have been very interested in trucks, bridges and construction sites. Educators created a construction corner in the classroom where they printed off local pictures and labelled them "Bill Thorpe Walking Bridge" and "Hartland Covered Bridge". Railway tracks, cars, trucks, wooden blocks and a laminated sign with "Let's Build a Bridge" complete the construction area.

In the Afterschool class the children were observed playing a matching game. The Educators were seen playing the games and following the children's lead, setting up a new activity as they lost interest in the matching game. The children recently had learned about space. The door was decorated with a large moon painted on it and the children had their pictures taken and were Astronauts.

In all the classrooms webbing was observed. Pictures of the children and their families were posted, and the children's artwork was displayed. Cleaning checklists were posted, and all are up to date. Smooth transitions were observed in all the classrooms and the children appeared to be comfortable with the routine. Tables and floors were cleaned after children had snack and proper hand washing was observed throughout the visit.
