Comments: Deficiency is now compliant  Licensing staff noted that cleaning supplies were up high and inaccessible to children, they are required to be stored in a cabinet or closet that is secured with a lock and key. Please ensure the cleaning supplies, such as bleach, Lysol, and Mr. Clean are stored in a cabinet or closet and secured with a lock and key. When licensing staff brought this to the administrator's attention, she immediately moved the cleaning supplies to a locked cabinet.			

<p><b>General Comments</b></p> <p>Licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility to conduct the yearly license renewal inspection. Children were still arriving for the day when licensing staff started observing the children play. When a new child arrived in the classroom, everyone greeted the child with much enthusiasm.</p> <p>The educators were very interactive with children and at the child's level. The children were supervised while in the washroom, during mealtime as well as playing in the classroom.</p> <p>Licensing staff observed only positive child guidance in every classroom throughout the inspection. The educators were very interactive and redirected children engaging in challenging behaviours. Educators were very compassionate and when a child was upset, the educators would hug the child and ask them what was troubling them.</p> <p>While observing the children in the 2/3-year-old classroom, the educators and children engaged in a very interactive circle time. The children and educators read "Brown Bear, Brown Bear" and had puppets that the children played with while following along with the story. After story time, the educators recognized that the children needed to "get up and move" and put on the "Gummy Bear song, Shake your Sillies Out song and the Baby Shark song."</p> <p>In every classroom, licensing staff noted an abundance of play materials for the children to play with.</p>
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General Comments

Each classroom took their turn participating in a gross motor activity in the gym. The children were observed dancing, singing, stretching, jumping, rolling along with balancing. The children were very patient while waiting for their turn.
