The classrooms were bright, clean, and welcoming. Several positive changes have been made since the last Monitoring Inspection in November. Current learning stories, evidence of purposeful planning through use of webbing were observed. Pictures of the children with their peers and artwork were on display throughout each classroom. The daily routine and classroom reminders were observed through visual postings on the walls which included pictures of the currently enrolled children. The 4/5-year-old classroom children were observed discussing signs of spring, reading a short story about a rooster and singing a few songs. Following circle time, pre-planned activities were set up for the children to explore. Children were observed using pastels and crayons to colour spring pictures. Another group of children were observed playing a fine motor skills game with the use of plastic egg and a ramp. Proper handwashing was observed in all classrooms before afternoon snack. The Educators were actively engaged with the children, offering hugs and assistance if needed.

Later in the afternoon, an Educator was observed waiting outside for the school aged children to arrive. Upon the school aged children's arrival, personal belongings were hung up and hands were washed as they entered their classroom. A small group of children were observed building with Lego while others played board games and coloured. The children are well represented in each of the classrooms throughout the facility using a variety of materials such as family pictures, colourful postings of multiple languages, books and national flags. Monthly fire drills are being performed and recorded.
