<p>General Comments</p> <p>Licensing staff visited the center in the morning to conduct a monitoring visit. The entry was welcoming with a separate Parent Board for each license, posted learning stories and a beautiful fish tank filled with colourful fish that the children can sit beside and admire. Attendance was down throughout the center today due to the Eid Holiday.</p> <p>The 2/3's Room was well set up for the children's use, with a bathroom and changing table and a variety of activity center set up such as housekeeping, reading corner, kitchen, dramatic play, baby dolls, stroller, barbies and dollhouse to name a few. This group went to the gym for gross motor play. In their kitchen center they had a very interesting learning story posted where they explored a Thanksgiving dinner with the plastic food and set up at the table, next they made play food turkey sandwiches and then they created real turkey sandwiches with mayonnaise, turkey, lettuce, tomatoes and bread and served and ate them together.</p> <p>The 3/4's group went to the gym earlier and when they returned, they had a lively circle time centered around literacy activities and focusing on the letter N. The sang songs about the days of the week and greeting each other and some of the songs incorporated actions and finger exercises. The educators informed me that the children represented 15 countries and the parents helped them build a wall display reflecting some of the places and countries represented. They referenced a nature walk that they had taken earlier in the week and the nest that they saw which started with the letter N. Connections were made with other objects starting with the letter N, and the letter was traced in the air with their finger, their noses and their feet. They were given a chance to play afterwards with tearing paper and painting on a pre-printed paper N or to engage in free play at the numerous centers already set up. They have a Doctor/clinic center, a housekeeping center with child sized brooms etc., a cozy reading corner with lots of books, a sensory table with kinetic sand and spring objects and block center with a good variety of large and small blocks for building.</p> <p>The 4/5-year-olds were in the gym doing a gymnastic lesson. Their room is shared with the afterschool program, and it contained a wonderful project on bees that they had created for Spring with a model of a hive and bees hanging from the walls etc. They used their space really well to reflect a lot of different interests. There was a Hair salon and Spa, a music making corner, an art section with open materials that they children</p>

could select, a big screen for music and dancing, reading corner and rug, sensory table, games, maps and blocks for building in various types and sizes, dramatic play with costumes and baby dolls. this group is getting ready to graduate and they are practicing their graduation dance and songs.

The staff files of new staff were verified, and the educators used the office to do daily planning and create their lesson plans. The afterschool do not arrive until after 2: 30 pm and they were not observed during this monitoring visit.
