General Comments				
A Monitoring Inspection occurred this afternoon, June 26th, 2024.				
During the inspection, children were observed engaging in indoor free play. Educators mentioned that the children are currently very interested in summer camp activities, including arts experiences, swimming at the school pool, and being active outdoors. Educators were observed using positive language and giving gentle reminders while actively participating in the children's activities. The facility maintains a daily incident log and allows parents of children present at the center to enter at any time. Monthly emergency evacuations are completed and posted, and there is a clearly visible and prominent place to post the license, current inspection report, current monitoring reports, and orders for compliance. The daily routine is posted in each room, and evacuation procedures are prominently located. The rooms are set up in an inviting manner, with materials arranged to encourage children to play. The facility has a varied supply of appropriate equipment, materials, books, and toys, and well-defined learning and play areas. Several pieces of children's artwork are displayed throughout the facility. Toxic products, such as chemical products and cleaners, are locked and inaccessible to children, and outdoor stationary equipment is surrounded by protective surfacing of appropriate depth. In terms of curriculum, daily activities are purposefully planned and documented in the program, offering opportunities for both individual and group experiences.
