General Comments					

A Monitoring Inspection occurred on August 27, 2024, with observations made in various aspects of the childcare facility.

Children were observed during outdoor free play and their transition to lunch, where proper handwashing was practiced during the transition indoors.

Educators shared that the children are currently very interested in being active outdoors, attending guest speaker sessions, participating in pizza parties, swimming in the pool, and enjoying dance parties. Positive language and gentle reminders were consistently used by the educators, who also played an active role in the children's outdoor activities.

The facility ensures that outdoor play occurs for at least one hour in each four-hour block of time when the majority of children are in attendance, weather permitting. Monthly emergency evacuations are conducted and posted, and a clearly visible area is designated for displaying the license, current inspection and monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance. Books have been selected to reflect the children's interests, and their artwork is displayed at eye level, complete with names and dates. Well-defined learning and play areas were observed, with several pieces of the children's artwork showcased throughout the facility. Outdoor stationary equipment is surrounded by protective surfacing of appropriate depth.

Daily activities are purposefully planned, providing opportunities for children to express creativity, explore the arts and sciences, experience accomplishments, solve problems, and develop trusting, respectful, and supportive relationships. Several pictures of recent activities were displayed throughout the facility, reflecting the engaging and dynamic learning environment.
