In each classroom, there is a display and storage of toys, program materials and supplies. There is a large choice and variety offered to the children. The program is purposefully planned and demonstrates that planning is a process that involves engaging the children and reflecting on their interests and strengths. Currently, the educators are using documentation that includes learning stories, pictures, and charts. The environment is child centered.

A positive approach in the guidance of children is being maintained. Educators interact and take interest in what the children are doing. They do this at their level while offering encouragement, love and support to the children.

The outdoor play space has a variety of areas and surfaces. Licensing staff discussed the need for approved surfacing around one of the structures in the space. Administrator stated that it would be completed.

Licensing staff can recommend facility for licensing pending a current health inspection.
