Comments:	: During the renewal inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed that the cabinet in the kitchen containing toxic products had been left unlocked. All toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies must be locked and inaccessible to children. The operator immediately locked the kitchen cabinet. Deficiency is now compliant

The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site for the renewal inspection.

During the renewal inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed indoor play, Tae Kwon Do classes, snack time, as well as outdoor play. The Quality Assurance Monitor also observed the children participating in a crafting activity.

During the renewal inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed an EpiPen that had expired in June 2023. The Quality Assurance Monitor discussed with the operator the importance of regularly checking medication expiry dates. The operator must contact the parent to obtain a new EpiPen.

The Quality Assurance Monitor and the operator had a discussion regarding the importance of opportunities for outdoor play each day for the children.
