Comments: The Quality Assurance Monitor observed that two educators were missing their job descriptions in their files. The administrator must ensure that staff records include a description of each employee's duties and responsibilities. The administrator added the missing descriptions to the educators' files. Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: The Quality Assurance Monitor observed that five children are not signed in on the attendance sheet. The educator must ensure that daily attendance records are accurate at all times. This is essential for the safety of both children and educators, especially in the event of an emergency. The educator has added the times of the children who were initially missing from the attendance sheet. Deficiency is now compliant			
9(1) The child-to-staff ratio is one educator for each of the following groups of children of the same age receiving services at a full-time or part-time early learning and childcare centre: (a) three infants or fewer; (b) five children or fewer who are two years of age; (c) eight children or fewer who are three years of age; (d) ten children or fewer who are four years of age or older, but who are not yet attending school; and (e) 15 school-age children or fewer.	9(1)	Sep 18, 2025	Sep 18, 2025
Comments: The Quality Assurance Monitor observed that there were 17 children with only one educator present. The administrator must ensure that the child-to-staff ratio is maintained at all times within the same age group. The educator immediately redirected two children to another classroom to correct the ratio. The ratio is now maintained. Deficiency is now compliant			

General Comments

The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site for a monitoring inspection.

The Ratio was not respected during the visit.

The following element were verified:

- Outdoor play area
- Outdoor play area materials and equipment
- Posted in a visible and prominent place in the facility
- Incident records

During the Monitoring Inspection, it was observed that children were transitioning from afternoon snack time to independent play. It was also observed that some children were preparing to complete their testing to advance to the next level in Taekwondo.
