Comments: In 1 of the 10 children profiles verifies, the address of the 2 emergency contact was missing. In another child profile verified, the address of the 2 emergency contact was incomplete, only the city part was stated. The administrator must ensure that all child profiles are complete.

Comments: The Quality Assurance Monitor observed a cup of hot tea on a shelf in a classroom. The classroom was not in use during the inspection in reason of only having 10 children present during the inspection. Hot beverages must be put in a spill proof container. The educator took the tea mug in the kitchen where the children don't have access. Deficiency is now compliant			

General Comments
The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site in the morning to conduct a monitoring inspection. The ratio was respected during the inspection. The following elements were verified: - If all required documents are posted in a visible and prominent place in the facility - Child records - Signed consent in the children's file - Medication records - Medication - Incident records - Health - Child guidance

General Comments

The Quality Assurance Monitor observed a bottle of nail polish remover on a shelf in a classroom. The Quality Assurance Monitor ask that the bottle be put out of reach of the children. The educator placed the bottle on a shelf that was not in the children's reach.

The Quality Assurance Monitor observed that the children did not go play outside during the inspection. The educator informed the Quality Assurance Monitor that an outing at the local outdoor pool was planned for today. After considering the pending weather, the outing was cancelled. The educator in charge informs the Quality Assurance Monitor that the children go play outside in the morning and after eating their lunch if the weather permits outdoor play.

The children were observed engaged in coloring sheets and playing in the indoor play area. The Quality Assurance Monitor observed the children playing with Legos and painting. Positive interactions were observed between the educators and the children.
