General Comments
<p>A Monitoring Inspection occurred July 2025!</p> <p>The children were observed engaging in a variety of activities indoors, outdoors, and during transitions between environments.</p> <p>During indoor play, children participated in circle time where they sang songs and listened to a story read by the educator. This was followed by a transition to snack time. Handwashing was observed prior to eating. Educators sat alongside the children, actively engaging in meaningful conversations.</p> <p>Following snack, the group transitioned outdoors. Educators applied sunscreen and offered gentle reminders for children to wear their hats and bring their water bottles outside.</p> <p>Outdoors, children were observed climbing on the dome, creating potions, navigating an obstacle course, and riding in Cozy Coupe cars.</p> <p>Educators reported that the children are currently interested in plants, butterflies, nature, water play, and sensory experiences. Evidence of these interests was documented throughout the room, including individual child portfolios, learning stories, learning webs, photographs, and children's artwork.</p>

General Comments

A clearly visible and prominent area is designated for posting the facility's license, current monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance. Additional documentation observed included daily attendance records, one staff file, and records of evacuation and monthly fire drills.

A conversation took place with the operator on the following:

Educators to ensure wood logs are not at the base of the climbing dome. As this is a safety hazard. Operator stated more play sand is on order for the sandbox.
