<p><b>General Comments</b></p> <p>Licensing staff arrived at the facility at 9am. Upon arriving, the children were engaged in free play activities such as playing with magnetic blocks, reading books with an educator and playing with toy cars and trucks. The educators were observed sitting on the floor with the children and actively engaged in their activities. The educators asked the children to wash their hands and gather their lunch box for morning snack. Hands were washed and the children sat down to eat. As some children did not want to eat, the educators allowed the children to return to free play.</p> <p>After morning snack, the children were asked if they wanted to have "morning meeting" were the children and educators sit on a carpet and sing welcome songs together. The children agreed as a group and the educators sat down with the children on the couches and carpet. After signing welcome songs, the children were observed getting ready to play outside. The educators were observed helping the children get dressed and praising them for their hard work. Once everyone was ready, the educators brought their first aid bag and attendance records outside with the children.</p> <p>While outside, the children played with a variety of outdoor play materials such as trucks, shovels, slides, tunnels and sport equipment. The educators were observed playing with the children while encouraging them to remain safe. An educator was observed sliding down a slide with a child while another educator played in the dramatic playhouse with a group of children. A variety and sufficient outdoor play materials were observed. The gate leading from the outdoor play area to the parking lot does not close as accumulated snow and ice are present. Please ensure that the gate can fully open, close and properly latch to comply with regulation 31 (6).</p> <p>After playing outside, the children lined up at the door and entered the facility for lunch.</p>
