General Comments

A Monitoring Inspection was completed this afternoon.

Infants – Upon arrival, the infants were observed during outside play. Infants were observed playing with toy cars, riding bikes, and climbing through tunnels. Educators were observed blowing bubbles. A conversation was had with educators regarding Hot Wheels. Hot Wheels are to be kept out of reach, while the infants are playing outside. Educators were observed collecting the Hot Wheels and removing them from the infants reach. Educators stated that the infants are presently interested in books and music. Educators stated that the children presently love the song, The Wheels on the Bus.

Two / Three – Children were observed during free play. A group of children were observed sitting in the cozy reading area, listening to an educator read. Others were observed drawing, cutting, and gluing. Educator was observed giving the children a 5-minute warning before clean-up / snack. When the timer rang, children were observed cleaning up their toys, lining up to wash their hands, and preparing for snack.

Three / Four – Children were observed during free play. A group of children were sitting with an educator, drawing pictures. One child was observed reading a book, in the cozy reading area. A group of children were observed building a blanket fort, and another groups of children were observed building with Magnetic tiles. Educator stated that the children are presently interested in arts & crafts, the doctor center, and magnetic tiles.

School Age – The school aged children were observed during free play. The school aged room appeared larger than it did, in previous inspections. Educators had rearranged some furniture, and it has created more space. Children were observed drawing, creating leaf people, working on a puzzle, building with Magnetic tiles, and playing with Hot Wheels.

Several forms of documentation were observed in each of the rooms – photos of children, learning stories, and children's artwork.

Attendance records were observed and were accurate.
