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General Comments

Licensing staff arrived at the facility at 10:30am. Upon arriving, the children in the Tulips and Wildflowers classrooms were observed playing outside. The educators were actively engaged in the children's activities. Once it was time to go inside, the educators prompted the children to help clean up the outdoor play area before transitioning outside.

Once inside, the owner/ operator was observed helping the children and educators' transition inside to the classrooms. The children's personal belongings were properly stored in their cubbies. Hand washing and diaper changing occurred before the children sat down at the sanitized lunch tables to eat. The educators were observed setting out the children's lunches and were observed helping the children open their containers. The educators were observed sitting with the children and supervising them as they ate. The educators were heard encouraging the children to remain seated while eating to ensure they were safe. An educator was observed re-directing a child that was engaging in free play activities to the lunch table with their peers. The educators were observed kneeling to speak to the children and were actively listening to the children as they spoke.

As the children finished eating their lunches, an educator was observed prompting the children to put their lunch boxes away and wash their hands. Licensing staff observed an educator standing in the washroom while supervising the children. After, the children in the 2's classroom were observed getting ready for nap time. The educators were observed preparing the children's beds for nap time. During this time, the children engaged in free play activities.

During nap time, the 4/5-year-old classroom was observed engaging in quiet time activities. The owner/ operator was present in the classroom, supporting the educators during quiet time activities. An educator was observed setting out invitations for the children to engage with. An educator was observed reading a book to a group of children while another was supervising the "tower building" activity. The owner/ operator was observed sitting on the ground, playing with blocks and Legos with a group of children.

The indoor environment was clean and well organized. The staff files were verified and found to be complete. Various and sufficient indoor play materials were observed.
