| The Quality Assurance Monitor observed the following: -Child-to-staff ratios -Daily activities -Staff records, including: name, address, date of birth, description of duties and responsibilities, a signed statement acknowledging obligations under the Act and licensing regulations, a copy of a criminal record check and vulnerable sector check, a Social Development check, and a valid first aid certificateNutrition: Oranges and veggie sticks were provided to the children, consistent with the posted menu. Water bottles were available and accessible to the children throughout the monitoring inspection.  During the monitoring inspection, the Quality Assurance Mentor observed multiple Halloween decorations outdoors, including spiders and spider webs, tombstones, pumpkins, and more. Indoors, there was a sensory bin filled with plastic Halloween-themed items such as small black cauldrons, miniature spiders, pumpkins, ghosts, bats, and tongs for children to use in manipulating the objects.  Additionally, there were large spiders made from black-painted paper plates, and witch hats crafted by the children using ribbons. Small pumpkins of various shapes and colors were also available for the children to explore through tactile play.
