The child's file must include the name, address, and home and work numbers of at least two people authorized by the child's parent to pick up the child and contact in case of emergency if the parents cannot be reached. During the renewal inspection, the operator/educator placed the addresses of both emergency contacts in the child's file. Deficiency is now compliant.
