Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that the addresses of 2 emergency contacts were missing in 1 of the 6 child files verified. The child's file must include the name, address, and home and work numbers of at least two people authorized by the child's parent to pick up the child and contact in case of emergency if the parents cannot be reached. During the renewal inspection, the operator/educator placed the addresses of both emergency contacts in the child's file. Deficiency is now compliant.			
48(2) An operator of a licensed facility may supply food to a child receiving services at the licensed facility that a parent or guardian of the child brings from the child's home if the food is labelled with the child's name and refrigerated, as required.	48(2)	Nov 21, 2022	
Comments: During the inspection, the inspector observed that 2 out of 4 lunchboxes were not labeled with the child's name. All food brought from home must be labeled with the child's name.			

General Comments
During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed indoor and outdoor free play. The inspector observed that a variety of toys are made accessible to children, allowing children to play based on their interest.
The inspector observed quiet time, during which the children played with puzzles and read books with the operator/educator. The inspector also observed lunch time and nap time during the renewal inspection.
The inspector observed positive interactions between the children and the operator/educator.
The operator/educator informed the inspector that no school aged children are attending the facility today.
The ratio is respected during the inspection.
