General Comments

The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site for a monitoring inspection. The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site during indoor free play.

The ratio was respected at all times during the inspection and the Quality Assurance Monitor was able to observe the children playing with water paints. Children were provided several types of paper to explore and mix colors. While the children engaging in the artistic exploration, the operator was positioned at the child's level and engaging in discussions by asking the children questions to further their exploration.

The Quality Assurance Monitor was able to confirm that the medications were locked and made inaccessible to the children during the inspection. The operator has confirmed that if they have medications used for anaphylactic shock, these will be stored safely but made easily accessible. The operator has confirmed that only the child's parents can provide medication, with the exception of acetaminophen. Medication that is non-prescribed are only accepted if they are in the original child safe container with the original label and labelled with the child's name and dosage. The operator confirms that when they receive prescribed medication, that the medication is also labelled with the doctor's name, instructions for use, and the time period for use.

The operator has confirmed that parents must notify them of their child's absence and must indicate if the absence is due to illness or other reasons. The operator confirmed that if a child becomes ill while they are at the facility that they are separated from the other children to be provided with care until someone is able to pick up the child, within one hour of notification of illness. The operator validated that children are provided with medical assistance is required and that the management of potential illness forms are completed as required. The operator confirmed that the parents are advised when a child has a communicable disease or illness.

The operator was able to show that the administration of medical records are evident and has validated that parent provide them with written or oral permission to give acetaminophen. The operator confirmed that when parents provide oral permission to give acetaminophen, a written confirmation is given when they pick up their child. The operator has confirmed that the administration of medication records are kept for each child as indicated in regulation 24(3).
