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General Comments Licensing staff arrived on site to conduct a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arriving, the children were finishing their morning snacks. The educators were observed sitting at the tables with the children. Conversation about the daily activities were had while the children ate. The school age classroom was heard taking a vote on what to name their indoor fort. In the preschool aged classroom, the educators were heard prompting the children to put away their lunch boxes and wash their hands after eating. The children were observed reading books while waiting for the rest of the children to finish their morning snack. The educators were heard prompting the children to use the washroom and change their shoes before going outside to play in the playground. The children were observed lining up at the door and an educator was heard signing songs while the children waited. A head count was done and the children headed towards the playground. While outside, the children were observed playing in the sandbox, engaged in imaginary play, driving plasma cars and playing on the play structure. An educator was observed engaging in imaginary play with a group of children. kneeling to speak to the children and offering to fix their hats. The children's water bottles were filled, and frequent washroom breaks were observed. Later, an educator was observed helping a group make compromises for play materials. The educators were observed circulation around the playground to ensure proper supervision. Storage bins were observed filled with various play materials. The playground was safe and was free of hazards. Shade and seating areas were provided. Licensing staff verified four child profiles and they were complete. The parent information board was posted in a visible area near the school age classroom and contained all of the necessary information. The fire evacuation practice for the month of July was not completed. Please ensure that fire evacuation practices are completed every month. The washrooms and indoor classrooms were clean and well organized.
