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<p><b>General Comments</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Visit completed at the establishment in the morning for a monitoring inspection.</li> <li>- During the visit ratio was respected.</li> <li>- The children's files include consent forms that are signed and dated by a parent or guardian. Children's files contain all required documents. A total of 20 out of 55 files were verified during the visit.</li> <li>- A daily incident log is maintained; parents are informed and sign the daily log.</li> <li>- Each child has an easily accessible space to store their personal belongings, which is labelled with their name and used only for the intended child.</li> <li>- Observations:</li> </ul> <p><b>2-3-year-old room:</b> Children were engaged in free play activities. Educators actively participated in and supported the children's play. During transitions, educators sang songs with the children. The children ate their lunch, which was provided by their parents. At the time of departure, the children were preparing for naptime.</p> <p><b>3-4-year-old room:</b> The following activities were observed during the visit: free play, handwashing, and lunch. Upon departure, the children were preparing for naptime.</p> <p><b>4-5-year-old room:</b> The children returned from outdoor play, washed their hands, and ate their lunch.</p> <p><b>After schoolers:</b> During the visit, after school children were engaged in free play activities, including art creation. The children ate their lunch and participated in a special activity, which included watching a movie. Discussion with the director on communicable diseases. The new communicable disease posters were distributed during the visit.</p>
