Comments: - Outdoor play materials were not sufficiently varied or available in adequate quantities to support the developmental needs and engagement of all children present.			

General Comments
- Visit completed at the establishment in the afternoon for a monitoring inspection. - Ratio was respected during the visit. - Posted in a visible and prominent place in the facility are the following documents: The licence, inspection report, orders for compliance, daily routine, evacuation procedures, name of administrator, name and telephone number of QA Monitor and inspector, when it applies a notice to inform parents of the existence of a communicable disease. - The outdoor play area is maintained in safe conditions. - The following administrative records are maintained on site: financial records; daily attendance of children and staff; menus and any substitutions; monthly emergency evacuation and fire drill records; and inspection and maintenance records for smoke alarms, smoke detectors, and fire extinguishers. - Monthly emergency evacuation and fire drills are completed. - A daily incident log is maintained; parents are informed and sign the daily log. - Each child who is in diapers has an individual storage space for diapers and changing supplies. The changing table is equipped with a safety strap and covered with a non absorbent surface. It is separated from food preparation areas and is located one metre or less from a sink. Children are always supervised during diaper changing routines. - Observation: Upon my arrival, the preschool children were napping, while the after-school children were playing outside. - 2-year-old group: During the visit, naptime, snack time, and free play activities were observed. - 3-year-old group: During the visit, naptime, snack time, and art activities were observed. The children also participated in a playdough activity. - 4-5-year-old group: Naptime and free play were observed. During free play, the children were looking at books and completing a puzzle with the educator.

General Comments

- After-school groups: Outdoor play, snack time, and free play were observed.
- In all groups, the educators were engaged in the children's play. They actively listened to the children and participated in conversations with them.
- Discussions with the director: A discussion took place regarding the outdoor play area. A plan is in place to add more materials and resources to the outdoor play space.
