### General Comments

A renewal inspection occurred on December 15, 2023. The children were observed in both inside and outside play as well as during to transitions. Morning snack, lunch, handwashing and diaper changing was also observed.

The new space was also inspected, and this gives the children an additional "break out" space if there is inclement weather or a change from the normal classroom environment.

Educators were observed engaging with the children during play and transitions and speaking respectfully and kindly to them.
