General Comments

Monitoring Inspection:

Children and educators observed engaged in a variety of activities this morning including outdoor play, sensory opportunities, dramatic play and building. The infants were observed exploring their learning environment some were engaging in dramatic play and the others were climbing on the small climbing structure and slide. The twos and threes were exploring the outdoor play area. A group of children were digging and building in the sandbox and another group were playing "police" with their educator.

Purposeful planning is evident through documentation, invitations and materials added to the environments to support the children's current interests (*Wheels on the Bus*, vehicles, coffee shop, space and letters). Documentation includes connections to the NB Curriculum Framework.

Infant Outdoor Play Area - Trash is piled in one corner and a large bin has a lid that is in poor repair. To be removed from outdoor play area and discarded.

Twos Room - small shelf with art supplies has some small nails protruding. QA Monitor discussed with educators using a hammer to push the nails in.

Next steps - adding age- appropriate loose parts to indoor and outdoor play areas. Examples of items to add, but not limited to stones, pinecones, shells, sticks, driftwood, cardboard tubes, boxes, jar lids, corks, fabric scraps, scarves, ribbon, keys, metal washers, spools, crates, baskets, planks, buttons and gems.

Handwashing routines were observed after outdoor play and before mealtimes.

Monthly fire drills are documented.

Daily attendance records are accurate and reflect all children present. Child-to-staff ratio was observed to be met during Monitoring Inspection. Infant Daily Information sheets observed to be completed throughout the day.

New staff file (1) review was completed. Signed statement and job description to be added to one staff file.

Three SD checks are expired - the administrator has submitted paperwork for new ones. Staff must not be left

alone with children until SD checks are complete.
Incident logs are complete and signed my parent/guardians.
Facility is currently meeting the 50% trained Early Childhood Educators (5/10) requirement.
