General Comments

A Monitoring Inspection occurred November 2025

The children were observed in the indoor and outdoor environments, including transitions between the two.

Panda Bear Room: The children were observed drawing at the table, looking at books, and playing with water in the sensory table indoors.

Outdoors: The children were observed riding in Cozy Coupe cars and exploring ice that was on the deck. The educator indicated that the children are currently interested in water play, books, and climbing.

Honey Bears Room: The children were observed eating snack. After snack, the children transitioned to circle time where the educator read a book indoors.

Outdoors: The children were observed drawing with chalk, playing in the mud kitchen, and playing with animal figurines. The educators indicated that the children are currently interested in animals, Christmas, fairies, and playing with Play-Doh and clay.

Polar Bear Room: The children were observed playing with trucks, driving cars around the room, and playing with dress-up clothes indoors.

Outdoors: The children were observed going down the slide, pushing Tonka trucks, running, and going down the slide again. The educators indicated that the children are currently interested in trucks, dress-up, baby dolls, and sensory activities.

School Age Room: The school age children were not in attendance at the time of inspection.

A clearly visible and prominent area was designated for posting the facility license, current monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance. Additional documents observed included incident logs, daily attendance records, daily information sheets, one staff file and monthly emergency evacuation and fire drills.
