Comments:

During the inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor noticed that a child was sitting alone at a table. The Quality Assurance Monitor asked the educators why the child was sitting at the table by himself. The educator shared that the child had bit another child. The Quality Assurance asked if there are other ways that they could accompany the child in a more positive manner without placing the child in reflection. The Quality Assurance Monitor reminded the educators that time-outs are not permitted in early childhood facilities and that other means must be used to give children tools to self-regulate and develop conflict resolution skills. The Quality Assurance Monitor offered some suggestions such as re-directing the child to do an activity to do reparations. An educator approached the child and asked the child if they wanted to do a drawing to offer to their friend to show that they are sorry and that they like playing with them. The child agreed and proceeded to draw. The educator then accompanied the child to offer the drawing to their friend. The administrator and educators must ensure that the guidance of the children is positive and includes positive reinforcement, encouraging efforts and recognizing accomplishment. Educators must demonstrate that they take the time to understand children's messages (cues) and will respond to children with the encouragement, praise, comfort and independence as needed. Resources that can be consulted by the Operator, Administrator and the Educators can include: The Operator Manual for Full-time and Part-time Early Learning and Childcare Centres Section 8.2 Child Guidance. The NB Curriculum Framework and the Professional Support Documents, Collaborative Assessment Tool (CAT) Collaborative Assessment Tool - Reflective Guide (CAT-RG). Deficiency is now compliant
