Infants are only to be mixed with preschool children outside of the hours of 8:30am and 4:30pm. One staff member immediately brought the infant to the infant class. Deficiency is now compliant

Comments:  This is a second reminder. Only the administrator and one staff member holds a one-year Early Childhood Education certificate. The administrator and 50% of educators must hold a one-year Early Childhood Education Certificate or training that is equivalent. The plan provided by the administrator to meet this regulation, back in January 2024, has not been successfully achieved. The Quality Assurance Monitor requests a new plan by the end of this week.
