General Comments

Licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility on July 18th, 2024, to conduct a follow-up license renewal inspection.

While reviewing the educator's files, licensing staff noted that all staff have a signed declaration confirming that the staff member has read and understood his or her obligations under the Act and Regulation 24(1).

While reviewing the children's files, licensing staff noted that all child files reviewed, on the day of the follow-up license renewal inspection, had immunization records present each file.

Licensing staff had a discussion with the operator concerning professional learning hours, and the operator stated that the educators who did not have the required professional learning hours are still working on obtaining these hours. The operator is going to send a plan on how the educators will finish up the required training. and the Quality Assurance Monitor will check in with the operator concerning this at their next scheduled Monitoring inspection.
