Administrator to email new Social Development Checks to Inspector once received. The two staff cannot be alone with the children until new Social Development Checks are completed and verified.			

<p>General Comments</p> <p>A renewal inspection occurred on February 10, 2026. Inspector observed the children and educators in all five early learning environments.</p> <p>In Infant 1 Room: Inspector observed the children during morning free play, waking up from naps, diaper changing and lunch.</p> <p>Inspector observed that documentation of the children's learning was displayed on the walls. Pictures of the children engaged in creating paper hearts using glue, construction paper and paper plates. Pictures of the children exploring paint with the fingers, observing the wildlife outside and exploring bubbles were also posted in the learning environment</p> <p>Infant 2 Room: Inspector observed the children getting ready for outside play, diaper changing, lunch and preparing for nap/quiet time.</p> <p>Pictures of the children are documented and displayed in the learning environment showing the children exploring with color, lights and movement, and exploring loose parts. Children were also observed by the Inspector exploring the kitchen centre.</p> <p>Educators in both Infant 1 and Infant 2 rooms were observed down on the floor at the level of the children,</p>

engaged with them in their learning, play and conversations.

Infant 3 Room/Toddler Room, Inspector observed the children arriving back from outside play, preparing for lunch and nap/quiet time

Documentation was observed displayed on the walls showing the children's art, creating puffy paint snowmen, making dinosaur eggs and exploring with bears and sticks.

Educators in this room were observed tending to the needs of the children, reading a book to the children while they waited for lunch to be served and arranging the room for nap/quiet time.

Junior Pre-K Room: Inspector observed the children returning from outside play, preparing for lunch, nap/quiet time.

Documentation on the walls show samples of the children's art, exploring puffy paint, investigating textures through art. Pictures of the children exploring books, creating with wooden blocks and adventures from neighborhood walks were observed.

Pre-K Room: Inspector observed the children during inside free play as well as returning from outside play. Samples of open-ended art; creating rainbows, racing cars in the paint, and using paint and balls was observed.

Documentation on the walls depicted the children exploring numbers in the tuff tray, exploring the snow outside by making snow angels and building shapes with the snow.

In all five learning environments, handwashing was observed occurring numerous times during the inspection. All staff member's files were reviewed, and a random review of twenty children's files occurred.

Inspector observed educators using positive child guidance techniques when speaking to the children and using re-direction.
