General Comments						
Afterschool care is very short for this age group as they only arrive at the facility at approximately 3 pm. Upon arrival the children went directly to the outdoor play area. As it was a nice day, the educators wanted to give the children the opportunity to play outside after being at school all day.  The children have access to tether ball, a climbing structure, a slide, picnic tables, soccer balls and nets. The educators advised me that the children were actively interested in soccer, and it was evident at the time of visit.  The educators were engaged with the children. They were observed having conversations with them and taking an interest in their school day or what they were doing. One educator was sitting at a picnic table with the children while the other was located near the slide. Supervision was adequate at the time of visit.  The daily schedule was posted on the inside of the classroom. It included pick-up, snack, outside and activity and free play / pick up. The educators did advise me that they try and follow the children's lead as far as the schedule is concerned. They prepare pre-plan activities and use the Hi-Mama app to keep track of what they are doing however the plan does remain flexible to meet the needs of the children.  The indoor environment is set up with many learning centres. It includes a reading centre, air hockey table, lego, dramatic play, card games, an art centre, blocks, games, and a sensory table. The reading centre had bookmarks that were made by the children and the children's artwork decorated the classroom. It was seen on both the windows and walls.  All documentation was verified for licensing purposes. It is kept in an organized and complete manner.
