General Comments

Upon arrival of licensing staff, the children had not returned from school yet. Once the children arrived, they went directly outside. Some children sat at the picnic table to have snack while others played. A lot of children were playing with, and trading, playing cards. Some had Marvel cards and others had Pokémon cards. Some children were climbing on the climbing structure and a group decided to start a game of Soccer-Baseball. The educators were supervising and engaging with the children.

An educator asked the children if they wanted to make potions. One group of children wanted to go, and others wanted to continue playing outside. One group transitioned inside and sat at the table for the activity. For the potion, the children could add colouring, sparkles, letters, and various balls and beads. The bottle was then filled with water, oil, and glue. The educators were observed helping the children. An educator explained that they will glue the lids shut and the children could bring their potions home the next day. After the activity, the group returned outside and continued playing.

The indoor environment was clean and well-organized. Various materials and resources are accessible to the children, such as blocks, board games, dolls, books, art supplies, and an air-hockey table. The children's artwork and pictures are posted on the walls. The outdoor environment was well-maintained and free of hazards. Various resources are available, such as climbing structures, a house, balls, tires, rackets, and frisbees. Child files were checked and contained all required documents.
