Comments: Inspector was unable to verify that all eligible educators had completed 10 hours of professional learning hours. Administrator must ensure that proof of completion is on-site and that the eligible educators are completing their hours. The inspector spoke with the educators, and some confirmed that they had not completed any professional learning hours during the year.

Comments: The Quality Assurance Monitor was able to observe the 10 hours of professional development of the administrator but was not in measure to observe the 10h of PL hours for each staff member. The administrator must make sure that the staff completes their 10h of professional development in their renewal year period.
